

INSTRUCTIONS FOR USE

APPLICATION

1. Unpacking

Carefully remove the trap from the packaging.

2. Falten

Fold the trap along the designated lines to form its intended shape.

3. Activation and Placement

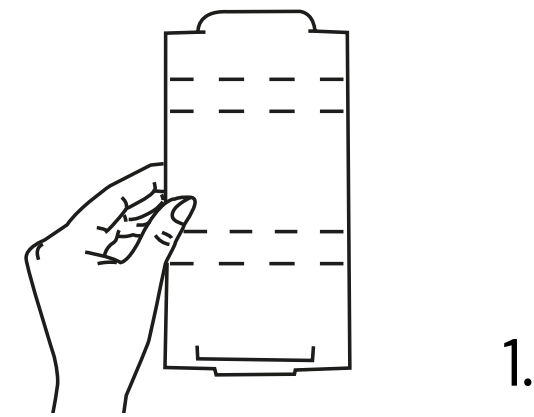
Es offers two options for placement:

a. Free-standing:

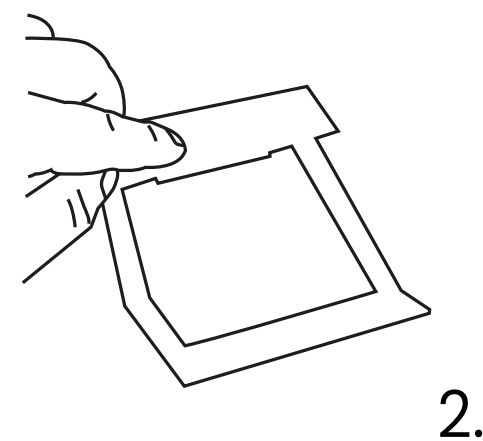
Remove the protective film from the main side of the adhesive surface and set up the trap.

b. For adhesive placement:

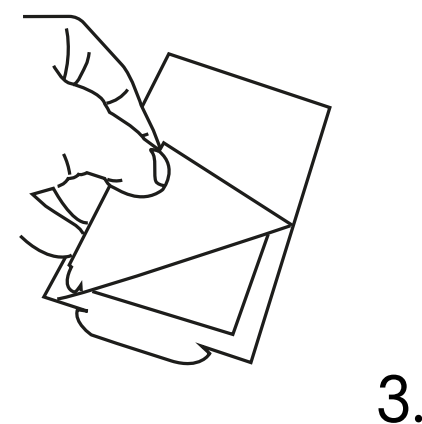
First remove the protective film on the back to expose the adhesive surface. Then stick the trap in the desired location (e.g. in a cupboard or drawer). Then remove the protective film on the main side to activate the trap.

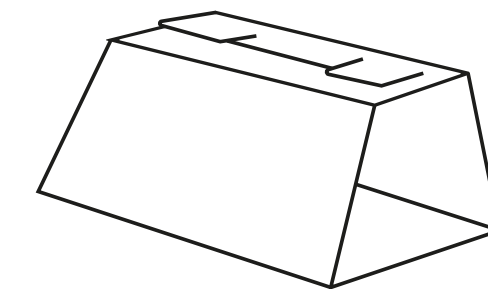

PLACEMENT OF THE TRAP

4. Choosing a Location

Choose places where food is stored or where you have sighted food moths. Suitable locations include:

- Pantry cupboards
- Kitchen shelves
- Pantries
- Drawers with dry food

5. Number

In larger areas or in case of heavy infestation, distribute several traps evenly.

MONITORING AND MAINTENANCE

a. Regular Inspection:

Check the trap regularly for caught moths.

b. Replacement:

Replace the trap after about 6–8 weeks or as soon as it is completely filled.

c. Monitoring Period:

Year-round use is recommended—especially from März to October.

SAFETY INSTRUCTIONS

- Außer Keep out of reach of children and pets.
- Do not stick directly onto food.
- Avoid contact with the adhesive surface – clean hands thoroughly after contact.

DISPOSAL

- Dispose of used traps with household waste.
- Avoid direct skin contact when disposing—wear gloves if possible.



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
