

IMIDASECT ANTS
Gel bait trays against ants

Use by general public

Formulation: Gel for direct application

Active ingredient: Imidacloprid

Chemical family: Nitroguanidines (neonicotinoids)

For indoor and outdoor use in buildings.

Target insects:

Pharaoh ants (*Monomorium pharaonis*), Argentine ants (*Linepithema humile*) and black trail ant (*Lasius niger*). Adults.

Mode of action:

The active ingredient Imidacloprid works by binding to the neurons of insects. This binding causes a disruption of nerve impulses, which is lethal to the target insects.

The ants are attracted to the bait's ingredients. The insects distribute the gel through their movement and poison their fellow ants through contact and ingestion of the gel.

Instructions for use:

Follow the instructions for use. Remove all natural food sources for ants (e.g., waste, food residues, etc.) from the affected area to promote the intake of the gel. If ants are indoors, place the bait trays near ant trails, entry points, and nests. If ants are outdoors, place the bait trays directly on ant trails or inside the nests.

Only apply in areas that are not flooded or wet, i.e., protected from rain, flooding, and cleaning water. Check the bait trays once a week. During inspections, assess the treated area and replace the bait tray if necessary. Do not use the product on absorbent surfaces. Apply the product in a way that it is not exposed to direct sunlight or heat sources (e.g., heaters). Avoid continuous application of the product. A noticeable reduction in ants is expected within 4 weeks. The effectiveness is proven only against adult worker ants, not against all ants in the nest. If the infestation persists despite following the label instructions, contact a professional pest controller. Inform the registration holder if the treatment is not successful. Remove bait trays when the infestation stops. Use the products in the recommended doses and intervals. Do not use neonicotinoids for follow-up treatments if resistance reduces effectiveness. Monitor problematic pest populations to detect early changes in sensitivity. To prevent the development of resistance to an active substance, use products with different modes of action alternately and avoid frequent repeated use of the same active substance. The use of biocidal products can be combined with other hygiene measures. Always use the products in accordance with the recommendations on the label.

IMIDASECT ANTS is recommended for use in: **living spaces** (including kitchens), **food processing areas:** processing: food manufacturers, kitchens, slaughterhouses, etc. storage: food retailers, warehouses, raw material storage, silos (excluding grain storage), etc. food preparation: restaurants, large kitchens, etc.; **public buildings:** permanently used areas such as infirmaries, hotels, public baths, municipal buildings, churches, halls, community centers, cinemas, etc.

The product can be continuously used for 2 months without replacing opened bait trays. Maximum 12 applications per year.

Step 1: Open the packaging and remove the bait boxes.

Step 2: To make the bait boxes ready for use, please separate the green stamped tabs. These tabs serve to protect the baits and must be removed for them to be effective.

Step 3: Place the bait boxes in the chosen location. Make sure they are easily accessible and close to the potential sources of the ant infestation.

Risk mitigation measures:

Do not use on or near food, feed, or drinks or on surfaces or objects that are likely to come into direct contact with food, feed, drinks, and livestock/pets. Avoid release into the environment.

Disposal:

Dispose of contents/container according to national disposal regulations. Do not allow unused product to enter the soil, waterways, drains (sinks, toilets...), or sewage system. Dispose of unused product, its packaging, and all other waste according to local regulations. The bait tray should not be cleaned before disposal.

Storage:

Do not store near food, beverages, and animal feed. The product must be stored protected from light. Shelf life is 48 months. Keep away from children and non-target organisms/pets.

First Aid:

If medical advice is needed, have packaging or label available. IF ON SKIN: Wash with water. If symptoms occur, call a poison center or doctor. IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. Call a poison center or doctor if symptoms occur. IF SWALLOWED: If symptoms occur, call a poison center or doctor. IF INHALED: Not applicable.
